



SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Halliford School pupils are expected to behave at all times, including on the way to and from School, with courtesy, consideration for others and common sense.
2. Bullying of any kind will not be tolerated and will be dealt with severely once identified.
3. Pupils are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times when in the School and when travelling to and from the School. Hair length and style must avoid eccentricity. Hair must be cut above the eyes at the front, above the collar at the back and be its natural colour. Jewellery of any kind, including studs and earrings may not be worn.
4. Pupils must be punctual for School and for individual lessons and practices. They are also required to take note of the academic expectations noted in the pupil diary.
5. Pupils are required to carry their diary with them at all times.
6. Halliford School is a non-smoking site. Pupils are also forbidden to smoke on the way to and from School. Chewing gum is also forbidden on the School site.
7. The taking and supply of drugs and alcohol is strictly forbidden while at School or on School trips. The taking and supply of drugs is likely to lead to permanent exclusion from the School. Sixth Formers will sometimes be allowed alcohol (not spirits) under staff supervision.
8. Anyone found guilty of theft will automatically be excluded from the School.
9. Mobile telephones, MP3 players, I-pods and other similar devices may only be used in form bases during break times and should be locked away at all other times. They must not be used during lessons and in other areas of the School.
10. Pupils in possession of motor cars may not bring them onto School premises and may not carry other pupils as passengers without express permission of both the families concerned.
11. Pupils who cycle to the School are expected to keep their bicycles in good repair. They are not to cycle on the premises and are to secure them in the racks provided.
12. Pupils attending any activity on the premises of the School outside normal school hours must keep to the areas designated for the activity.
